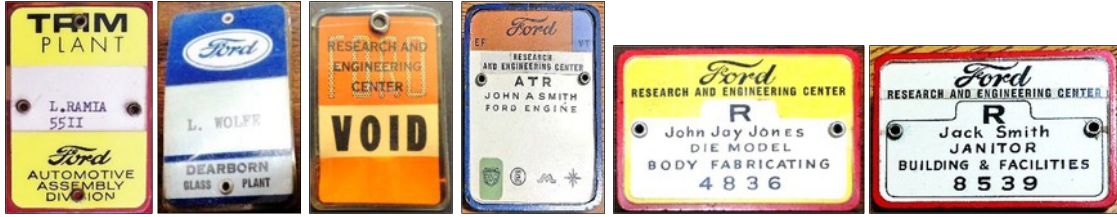

2. PAGE 69, PART A, NUMBER 1: Badge pictures and information in the text box below were added.



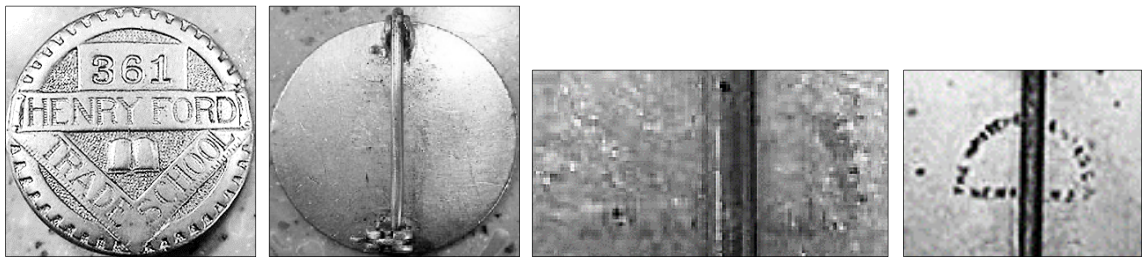
