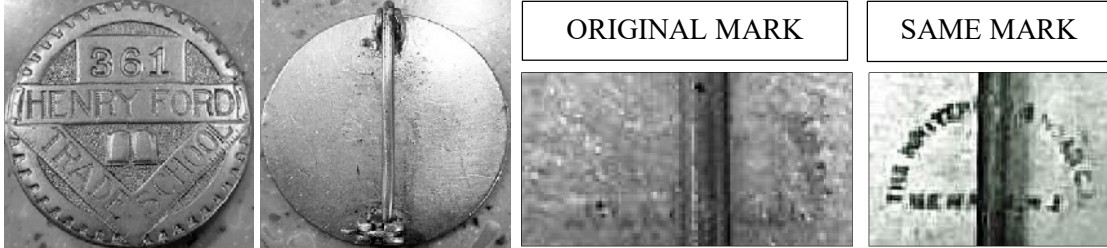

3. HENRY FORD TRADE SCHOOL TYPE II GEAR BADGE

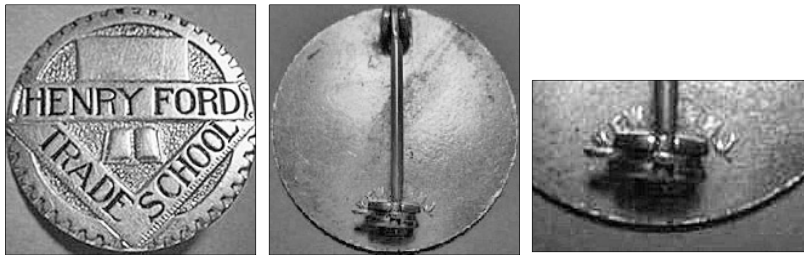

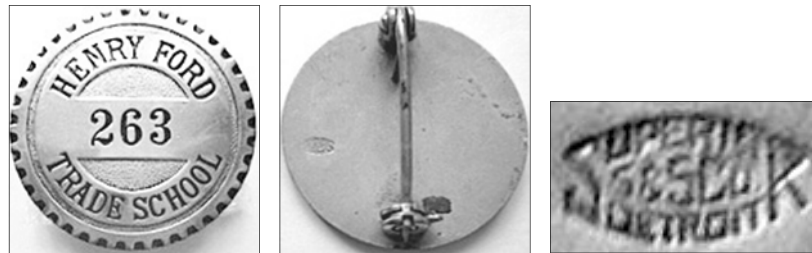

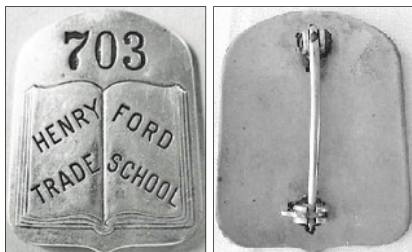
